### Organisation

The International Society for Pest Information (ISPI) is a non-profit organization, registered in Darmstadt, Germany, with the aim to promote information exchange on:

- animal pests, diseases and weeds in agriculture, forestry and stores
- arthropods (e.g. insects) which are harmful to livestock or affect humans directly.

We collaborate with scientists, professionals and research institutes active in the field of pest management. Among others, we assemble a database with scientific literature, addresses of authors, and other information on pests, diseases and weeds.

### Summary description of the site

This searchable database includes over 140,000 research publications and detailed information on numerous pest, disease and weed species, as well as beneficials.

You can browse the information on the site according to specific pest groups - plant pathogens, insect plant pests, other pest groups, including nematodes, weeds, and various other groups (including vertebrate pests and storage pests).

There is also information on beneficials and you can browse the details by the following beneficial groups - parasitoids and parasites; predators; diseases of pests; antagonists of plant diseases/nematodes and weed bioagents - natural enemies.
